Social Work Student Listening Post Feedback

ISSUE: MSW Seminar Sessions – education and application (what students are doing at their internships) Action: Statement added to liaison orientation - *Provide opportunity and time in each seminar for students to provide examples of what they are doing as it relates to seminar content* 

ISSUE: Response times by faculty liaison to students Action: Statement added to liaison orientation - *Be mindful that students are eagerly awaiting your guidance; provide alternative access options if email is not effective* 

ISSUE: Collaboration between faculty liaison and site supervisor Action: Statement added to liaison orientation - *Main collaborator in developing student skill* 

ISSUE: MSW Seminar Times – request to not schedule at end of workday Response: Office of Distance Education requirement for online cohorts to host seminars during night class sessions. Liaisons have more discretion for in person cohorts and online one year program cohorts.

ISSUE: Address field sites that don't align with SW ethical standards of conduct Response: Process in place includes maintaining documentation on student concerns, addressing concerns with field sites when appropriate and discontinuing partnership with field sites when necessary.

ISSUE: More guidance on how to "conduct oneself as a social worker" – requested checklist for each student Talking points:

Internship goal is to socialize practitioners new to the field

Don't require a checklist to be completed, but provide resources to students and field sites to use if needed
