

Hall of Excellence Award

The Hall of Excellence (HOE) Award is designed to honor individuals who have achieved distinction in their respective fields, including teaching, leadership, executive roles, healthcare, or administration. This award recognizes those who have inspired change, attained esteemed positions, or provided exceptional service to their communities.

A maximum of two HOE Awards will be granted per cycle. Each application is retained by the selection committee for a period of three HOE cycles.

AWARD ELIGIBILITY & CRITERIA

1. Educational Background:

Nominees must hold at least one degree from either the 'Department of Health Recreation and Community Services' or the 'Department of Kinesiology and Athletic Training'.*

2. Professional Achievements:

Nominees must have demonstrated a high level of professional success in their field. This may include, but is not limited to:

- Recognition from peers
- Unique achievements
- Exceptional dedication to community service
- Distinguished leadership
- Notable innovation as an entrepreneur
- Significant impact on their field

3. Years of professional service:

Nominees must have at least 10 years of service in their profession.

4. Employment Status:

Nominees must not be current employees of the university. However, emeritus professors are eligible for nomination.

5. Engagement:

Award recipients are expected to participate in Hall of Excellence activities.

* Department names have changed over time. Departments were formally known as the School of Health, Physical Education and Leisure Services (HPELS).

NOMINATION MATERIALS

- **Completed Nomination Form:** This can be a peer or self-nomination.
- **Two Letters:**
 - **Candidate's Cover Letter:** A letter from the nominee detailing their qualifications and achievements.
 - **Supporting Letter:** A letter from a colleague or other individual providing additional support for the nomination.
- **Curriculum Vitae (CV):** A detailed CV outlining the nominee's professional background and accomplishments.
