

Hall of Excellence Student Award

The HOE Student Award recognizes students who have engaged in significant professional and community activities beyond the classroom. This award honors students who have demonstrated exceptional engagement in their field of study.

One HOE Student Award will be granted per cycle.

AWARD ELIGIBILITY & CRITERIA

1. Educational Background:

- Nominees must hold at least one degree from either the 'Department of Health Recreation and Community Services' or the 'Department of Kinesiology and Athletic Training'.*
- Nominees must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher at the time of application.

2. Professional Achievements:

Nominees must have demonstrated engagement in significant professional and community activities beyond the classroom. This may include, but is not limited to:

- Holding a leadership role in a student or professional organization
- Volunteer work or community service
- Program development or coordination
- Entrepreneurship type initiatives

3. Years of professional service:

Nominees must be between 3 to 10 years post-graduation.

4. Employment Status:

Nominees must not be current employees of the university.

5. Engagement:

Award recipients are expected to participate in Hall of Excellence activities.

* Department names have changed over time. Departments were formally known as the School of Health, Physical Education and Leisure Services (HPELS).

NOMINATION MATERIALS

- **Completed Nomination Form:** This can be a faculty member or self-nomination.
- **Two Letters:**
 - **Candidate's Cover Letter:** A letter from the nominee detailing their qualifications and achievements.
 - **Supporting Letter:** A letter from a faculty or professional supervisor.
- **Curriculum Vitae (CV):** A CV outlining the nominee's professional experiences.
