Undergraduate Student Award

The HOE Undergraduate Student Award recognizes undergraduate students who have engaged in significant professional and community activities beyond of the classroom. This award honors students who have demonstrated exceptional engagement in their field of study.

One HOE Undergraduate Student Award will be granted per cycle.

AWARD ELIGIBILITY & CRITERIA

1. Educational Background:

- Nominees must be currently enrolled in an undergraduate degree within the 'Recreation, Tourism & Nonprofit Leadership major' or the 'Department of Kinesiology and Athletic Training.'
- Nominees must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher at the time of application.

2. Professional Achievements:

Nominees must have demonstrated engagement in significant professional and community activities beyond of the classroom. This may include, but is not limited to:

- Holding a leadership role in a student or professional organization
- Volunteer work or community service
- Program development or coordination
- Entrepreneurship type initiatives

3. Engagement:

Award recipients are expected to participate in Hall of Excellence activities.

NOMINATION MATERIALS

- **Completed Nomination Form:** This can be a faculty member or self-nomination.
- **Two Letters:**
 - **Candidate's Cover Letter:** A letter from the nominee detailing their qualifications and achievements.
 - **Supporting Letter:** A letter from a faculty or professional supervisor.
- **Curriculum Vitae (CV):** A CV outlining the nominee's professional experiences.
