MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

Minimum requirements apply to all chapters of AKD

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

- Be enrolled as a major or minor in a sociology program or a program sociological in nature
- Be at least a junior (third year)
- Rank in the top 35% of graduating class (or have an overall GPA of 3.3)
- Have a 3.0 GPA in sociology courses taken at the host institution
- Have completed at least four courses in sociology prior to initiation (the equivalent of 12 semester hours)

GRADUATE STUDENTS

••••••

- Be officially admitted to graduate study in sociology at the host institution
- Completed one-half year of graduate study in sociology
- Graduate GPA of a B or better
- Continue matriculation in a program of study leading toward a graduate degree in sociology at the host institution

Chapters may apply additional criteria for both undergraduate and graduate students. Sociology faculty members and those employed as sociologists may be inducted through their institution.


