Requirements for the CSBS Out-of-State and International Internship Award

- 1. Applicant must be a fully admitted (not prospective) undergraduate major in a CSBS program with a major GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- 2. All applicants must submit a completed application form by the due date associated with the internship period:
 - Summer Programs: March 1
 - Fall Programs: July 1
 - Winter and Spring Programs: November 1 of the preceding year
- 3. A current copy of your transcript.
- 4. Proof of enrollment in a CSBS approved internship program.
- 5. A brief essay on how you anticipate that the internship will advance your educational and professional development.
- 6. Letter of support from a CSBS faculty member which comments on the relevancy of the internship and the quality of the student.
- 7. Within one month of completion of the program, submit a brief (one or two paragraphs) summary of your experience to the Office of the CSBS Dean.
